



## Rules Campingplatz Sportzentrum Zeltweg

---

Welcome to campsite Sportzentrum Zeltweg!  
We are pleased that you have chosen our campsite and we wish you a pleasant stay.

Anyone who enters the grounds of the Zeltweg sports center respects the rules of these house rules and unconditionally confirms the provisions of these rules. Any breach of the following guidelines may result in denial of access to the camping area or eviction from the site or closure of the site.

### § 1. arrival

Access to the campsite is only permitted after registration with the administration. We need your ID for registration (statutory registration obligation). This also applies to short-term visitors. Young people traveling alone up to the age of 16 must present written consent from their legal guardians when registering. A test certificate for liquid gas systems in vehicles (Gas-TÜV) is required. Persons with contagious diseases cannot be accepted as guests. By registering, the camper declares that they are free from such diseases and confirms the compliance with these campsite regulations.

### §2. Check -In

At check-in you will receive the accreditations (one bracelet per person and one license plate per vehicle) to access the campsite. These must be placed immediately on the wrist or inside the windshield to gain access. The house rules were given to you at check-in. These are also signposted in the entrance area.

Make sure that you always carry a valid form of identification (identity card, passport or driver's license) with you. For safety reasons, after the first access to the camping area during the contract period, further leaving the camping area with vehicles is only permitted in exceptional cases.

### § 3. departure

Departure is only possible from 8 p.m. on the day of the event. The campsite closes no later than 12:00 a.m. on the Monday after the event weekend.

### § 4. care

The campsite is accessible 24 hours a day, no liability is accepted for valuables. The campsite is looked after directly by our campsite attendants, who you can call [+43 677 64 62 72 06](tel:+4367764627206) if you have any questions.

On-site supervisor: 6 a.m. to 3 p.m

Availability: 3 p.m. to 6 a.m

### §5. vehicles

Cars and motorcycles must be parked next to the tent or caravan in such a way that they do not obstruct traffic and the neighbours. In principle, only one car is permitted per parking space. Additional cars can be parked in the signposted parking spaces. In general, a speed limit of 5 km/h applies in the entire campsite area.



#### §6. disturbance

Please be considerate of the other camping guests and avoid disturbing noise. In particular, radios, televisions, music systems and musical instruments, etc. are to be used in such a way that the neighbors are not disturbed. Playing football is generally only permitted in the area provided for this purpose (artificial turf field).

#### §7. Quiet hours

We have quiet times from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. During this time it is not allowed to enter the campsite with vehicles of any kind. Guests wishing to access the site during these times are asked to park their vehicles in the parking lot in front of the sports center and use the pedestrian entrances. Sporting activities that cause noise are not possible during quiet times.

#### §8. Safety and danger

It is not allowed to dig ditches or fence your pitch on the campsite. Make sure that no one is endangered by tent pegs, tent cords or other camping accessories. Identify sources of danger that are difficult to identify with clearly visible markings.

#### §9. Restrooms / showers

Basically, the sanitary facilities and showers are cleaned daily. Nevertheless, we ask you to comply with a certain hygiene standard so that future guests can also use the facilities without restrictions. Defecation outside of the sanitary facilities is prohibited.

#### §10. waste disposal

When you register, you will receive a rubbish bag for disposal. In order to keep our campsite as clean as possible, we ask that you dispose of your rubbish in these bags and close them. In addition, there are enough rubbish bags available throughout the campsite, as well as rubbish separation systems at neuralgic points.

#### §11. BBQ / campfire

**Campfires or open fires are PROHIBITED on the entire site!!**

Grilling (gas or charcoal) is only allowed in suitable containers on the campsite. Embers and fire are to be supervised at all times. If there is an increased risk of forest fires, the groundskeeper can issue a barbecue ban.

Smoking is only permitted on your own pitch or in the designated smoking area.

#### §12. damages

In the event of damage to the facilities and facilities of the campsite and the entire sports center, the person who caused the damage is liable. These must be reported to the organizer immediately, even if the visitor is obliged to remove them himself. Any costs incurred will be invoiced. We accept no liability for theft or damage to guests' property by third parties, injury, or accidents. We therefore recommend private provision in the form of insurance.



#### §13.pets

All pets brought along must be registered. Dogs are not allowed to run around freely (must be on a leash and wear a muzzle). No danger or unacceptable disturbance should emanate from the animal. The animal owner is liable for any incidents. Animal contamination is not allowed on the campsite. Should this nevertheless happen, they must be removed immediately by the pet owner.

#### §14. domestic authority

If it is necessary the management may refuse to admit people or expel them from the campsite to maintain safety and order on the campsite. Persons who are obviously under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs and who want to enter the camping site may be turned away. The applicable youth law applies, i.e. persons under the age of 18 are not allowed to drink alcohol at the campsite.

#### §15. Food and drinks

It is allowed to bring your own food and drinks to the campsite. Please note that these are not packaged in glass as the use of glass is not permitted throughout the campsite. It is also not permitted to bring external guests to the campsite.

#### §16. dresscode

Wearing club clothing or clothing showing affiliation with a specific political or social/ideological movement may be refused. Clothing branded a Formula 1 or MotoGP teams are allowed.

#### §17.prohibites items

Drugs, weapons, drones, laser pens, fireworks, smoke powder, smoke bombs, gas and oil lamps, dry ice, large gas bottles (>11kg), candles and torches, and dangerous objects in general are not permitted. Throwing objects of any kind or spilling liquids of any kind, especially in the direction of other people, is prohibited.

#### §18. behavior rules

Socially responsible behavior is required at the campsite. Threats, use of force, discriminatory language and/or gestures, sexual harassment and other anti-social behavior will not be tolerated. Such violation may result in a warning and subsequent removal from the campsite. Any damage must be compensated by the perpetrator. In addition, the operator reserves the right to take legal action (e.g. lawsuit for trespassing, reporting to authorities or court, etc.). Furthermore, climbing or climbing over buildings and facilities that serve general use, in particular fences, chairs, benches, tables, fences, barriers, lighting systems, trees, stages, masts of all kinds, decorations or similar, is prohibited. Likewise, these may not be written on, painted over or pasted over.

#### §19. Video control

The landlord reserves the right to monitor the entire event site or parts of it with a video system. Without accreditation, guests are not permitted to use professional camera equipment on the area.



#### §20. Advertising material

The distribution of advertising material, prospectuses, flyers and/or the trade in goods or the sale/brokerage of admission tickets is prohibited on the campsite without the written consent of the organizer.

#### §21. electricity

220 V power connections are available for place.

#### §22 electric vehicles

Charging electric vehicles at the parking space is prohibited. Use can lead to an overvoltage and subsequently to the collapse of the entire power system.

You will find suitable charging stations in the entrance area, as well as fast charging stations in the immediate vicinity.

#### §23. water supply

Washstands are available at the campsite.

#### §24. emergency service

In the event of danger (fire, accidents, etc.), the security personnel, the organizer and/or the blue light organizations (fire brigade 122, police 133, rescue 144) must be informed.

#### §25. weather

It is expressly pointed out that in the event of a storm, all participants are responsible for taking suitable protective measures. In particular, staying under trees or in the immediate vicinity of technical structures can represent danger and should be avoided.

#### §26. following items are not allowed at the campsite

In case of doubt, the classification of objects as prohibited or allowed is the responsibility of the security staff or the organizer:

- weapons of any kind and items that can be used as a weapon or projectile (slingshot, knife, etc.)
- objects made of glass (e.g. glass bottles, glass containers, etc.), objects made of fragile or splintering material (e.g. jugs, etc.)
- pyrotechnic objects of any kind, flammable liquids, gas spray cans
- corrosive or highly flammable substances
- containers with substances that can endanger health
- drugs and other intoxicants
- solid carbon dioxide / dry ice
- safety vests / signal vests (worn by visitors)
- laser pointer
- drones and other flying objects (e.g. sky lanterns)
- powdered or coarse-grained materials
- Items with discriminatory or provocative text or image
- professional photo and video equipment
- Noise instruments (e.g. compressed air fanfares, gas horns, megaphones)
